Images for the internet

- 1. make the image small [no larger than 4 x6 6x4]
- 2. pixel size [not larger than 100, 50 is even better]
- 3. Add a watermark in a place not easily removed.
- 4. put a © symbol on image.
- 5. Let them copy your image.
